

## MTA FRANK VANDERVORT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP



### ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Must be a graduating senior attending a Modesto City Schools high school
2. Must be a son or daughter of an individual who is an active member of the Modesto Teachers Association and who has served as a site rep or committee member for at least two years with regular attendance and participation

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Must include a short essay explaining your educational goals (500 words or less)
2. Must enclose two letters of recommendation from site educators
3. Must enclose a complete copy of your high school transcript that includes first semester senior year, class rank, and GPA
4. Must include a short essay written by your parent stating his/her active involvement in MTA (i.e. time spent as site rep or on an MTA committee)(500 words or less)
5. Must file a completed application with all materials and transcripts to the Modesto Teachers Association by **4:00 PM Thursday, March 30, 2023**

### RECIPIENT REQUIREMENTS

1. A scholarship winner may attend any college or university of his or her choice including a junior college but must be enrolled in a full-time program in any field of study of his or her choosing to receive funds.
2. The scholarship award will be presented to the winner upon receipt of proof of registration.

### SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded with Committee discretion

### SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS CRITERIA

Applicants will be judged based on overall school record, activities, and application information, which includes parental involvement in MTA

***Incomplete applications will not be considered***
